This season (2010) only Advanced Pure Sound will be offered as an open category without devision (One Class) Self build Equipment is allowed.  2011 – Expert unlimited bonuspoints: Maximum 100 bonuspoints, the competitor must make a list with suggestions for maximum 150 points. Any item the competitor thinks is worth a bonus point can only appear once on the list.  Master Unlimited: In 2011 the amount of bonuspoints will be raised to 30 points
General	New: ESPL-ESQL – ESPL with tonal accuracy judged  Experienced 2000 and Advanced 4000, explanation  For these categories there is a limitation in money only. So, the use of external processors is allowed in these classes. Also there is no limitation in channels.	
Sound Quality	Technical track: depth perception (Stage depth) is taken out of the judging in all Categories	
Installation	Cables USB or iPod cables- or connectors for these devices will not be taken into consideration when judging installation.	
Installation	<b>External devices</b> : As long as external devices which are able to play the EMMA DVD/CD are turned off or disconnected during the judging process these devices will not be judged. This has to be proven by the competitor. The same rule applies for Rear Seat Entertainment Systems.

	<ol> <li>Page 25, paragraph 4.2.1</li> <li>Any power wire of the system connected to a positive battery post (including possible extra batteries) must be fused within 40 cm from the battery post (considering total wire length and/or length of metal bar). If the wire passes through any metal panel before the fuse, it must be properly protected with a grommet (not only tubing/sleeve!). There must be no risk for the cable to connect to metal before the fuse and this rule applies only to an additional battery in a sealed metal box This includes wiring for external charging systems / service connections etc. that are permanently installed.</li> <li>For any additional battery used, the wire length / length of metal bars between the positive posts must be shorter than 40cm, otherwise they should be properly fused.</li> </ol>	
MM	MM Experienced and MM Advanced will be judged with Dolby Digital 2.0. When judging these 2 classes the rear speakers must be turned off.	Judges are not allowed to compete in MM Experienced
ESPL	In ESPL Experienced the backseats might be folded down during the measurement procedure	
ESPL	Page 65, procedures and rules for ESPL Add paragraph to be able to measure voltage at the amplifiers  "ALL amplifier power terminals must be accessible during the measuring procedure. The judges are allowed to measure the voltage at any time during the measurement.	
ESPL	Original - Page 65, change paragraph 10 – please delete Cars with more than two midrange/-woofer speakers per side installed (front and rear together) must compete in the next higher competition category. Each two additional midrange/-woofers (e.g. #5&6) installed in the system will be counted as one additional woofer. The mid woofer(s) must be smaller then 20cm (8") / 6x9". Not used OEM speakers will not be taken in consideration. The competitor has to prove that the speakers are not connected to the audio system.	
	New paragraph text:  Competitors are allowed 1 x 8 inch speaker in front door (both sides) or any amount of speakers with a diameter smaller than 8 inch.  If there are more or larger speakers mounted than stated above, the competitor will move up to a higher category or class.
